



3rd Press Release Development of a systemic framework

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
The recent report from the SUSEDI project, supported by Erasmus+ and titled "Systemic Framework to Achieve Sustainable Educational Institutions Through Whole Institution Approach," has provided crucial insights into the strategies and practices necessary for transforming educational institutions towards sustainability.

The report emphasizes on the Whole Institution Approach as a critical framework for

embedding sustainability in educational institutions. It integrates social, pedagogical, and organizational pillars, ensuring that sustainability is woven into the very fabric of educational institutions.

Three Pillars of Sustainability

- Social Pillar: Focuses on fostering collaboration, transformative actions, and cultivating a green self- identity among stakeholders.
- Organizational Pillar: Involves creating sustainable infrastructure, implementing effective governance and educational functions while fostering leadership and
 - strategic planning that aligns with sustainability goals.



Pedagogical Pillar: Emphasizes on the importance of curriculum development,



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capacity building for teachers, and adopting innovative teaching and learning practices that promote sustainability.

The framework comes as a result of the analysis of 26 best practices and 14 expert interviews globally which highlighted the importance of:

- **Relevance**: Aligning sustainability efforts with the institution's mission, regional and national educational priorities, and community needs.
- **Resourcing**: Ensuring the availability of physical resources, technologies, expertise, and funding to support sustainability initiatives.
- Reflectiveness: Promoting critical reflection and continuous improvement in sustainability practices at all levels.
- Responsiveness: Adapting sustainability strategies to local contexts and cultural settings, and embracing flexible approaches.
- **Reformation**: Redefining the entire educational experience to embed sustainability deeply into institutional culture and practices.
