### **The MOOC for Transformation Agents Has Been Successfully Launched!**

We are excited to share that the SUSEDI Open Educational Resource (OER) for Transformation Agents was successfully launched and integrated into the SUSEDI online platform. This marks a significant achievement in equipping Educational Institutions (EIs) across Europe with the necessary expertise to drive sustainability using the Whole Institution Approach (WIA).

The OER was developed through intensive collaboration within the SUSEDI consortium and incorporates recorded materials from a joint four-day online workshop, Power-Point presentations, curriculum guides, and handouts. Designed according to EQF Level 6 standards, the MOOC served as both a training and self-learning tool for current and future transformation agents eager to lead change in their institutions.



# First Cohort of Transformation Agents Completed Their Training

The first group of Transformation Agents was successfully trained in June 2025. These professionals—educators, sustainability experts, and institutional leaders—were selected from across partner countries and undertook a robust learning process aimed at developing their coaching, facilitation, and change management capabilities.

Their strategic role was critical in supporting EIs throughout the SUSEDI transformation journey. They assisted schools and educational organisations in:


- Delivering advanced WIA training.
- Supporting the use of the self-assessment tool.
- Drafting institutional sustainability action plans.
- Facilitating change processes and overcoming resistance.

These agents played a pivotal role in aligning institutional structures and behaviours with sustainability principles, setting the foundation for long-term impact.

## Training, Tools & Certification Framework in Progress

To strengthen the role and recognition of Transformation Agents, the SUSEDI consortium initiated the development of a Certification Scheme aligned with ISO17024. The scheme is being designed to validate the agents' competencies and to certify their role in sustainability transition.

The framework includes the scope of certification, role profiles, skills and knowledge requirements, and code of conduct. Following the MOOC, participants underwent a comprehensive assessment to confirm their readiness to act as certified change leaders within their institutions.




## Driving Systemic Change Across Borders
